Deborah Goodman corrects inaccuracies in the News Shopper article:

"I lost FOUR members of my family to HD (my Dad, his sister and two of my brothers).

My Mum always said that she was guilty of Aiding and Abetting my brothers suicide and was therefore not 'tried' but sentenced at the Old Bailey. They didn't find her innocent, she pleaded guilty.

I went to Costa Rica when I was still working for the telecoms company.

I am really not happy with this last sentence....

"I also believe the law needs to change so Huntington's patients can be helped to die with dignity." It's awful. I did not say this. I do think that the law needs to change, but not so that HD patients can die! I apologise to anyone this may offend."
